

Metro cards for disabled students delayed

New Delhi: It might take a little more time for the physically challenged students of Delhi University to get their free Metro card, as the Delhi Metro Rail Corporation has expressed its inability to provide services like blocking of lost cards and

centralized recharging, in the current financial year.

Delhi University's Equal Opportunity Cell, as per its decision to provide Metro cards to PH category students, wrote to DMRC, requesting for around 1,300 metro-cards. DU author-

ities also requested a centralized recharging facility so that the university can recharge the cards online.

DMRC welcomed the move and said it is in the process of starting a facility of recharging through netbanking. TNN
