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Common Curriculum for Special Children

The National Council for Education, Research and Training (NCERT) and the concerned State Council for Education, Research and Training (SCERT) develop curriculum at national level and state level respectively. Special schools also follow the same curriculum. The curriculum is adapted as per the disability and the need of each child with disability.

Special schools are recognized by concerned board such as Central Board for Secondary Education or State Board, as the case may be. The concerned Boards award certificates to the children with disabilities. There are no specialized Boards for special schools.
