**Grievance Redressal Cell for Differently Abled**

The Chief Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities appointed by the Central Government under Section 51 of the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995 is responsible for monitoring implementation of the provision of the Act including Section 43.

As per Section 59 of the aforesaid Act, the Chief Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities is responsible to look into complaints with respect to matters relating to deprivation of rights of persons with disabilities, non-implementation of laws, rules, bye-laws, regulations, executive orders, guidelines or instructions made or issued by the appropriate Government and local authorities for welfare and protection of rights of persons with disabilities and take up the matter with the appropriate authorities.

This information was given by the Minister of State for Social Justice and Empowerment, Shri Krishan Pal Gurjar in a written reply to a question in Lok Sabha here today.
