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**Centres Working for Upliftment of Disabled Persons**

There are seven National Institutes (NIs), 236 District Disability Rehabilitation Centres (DDRCs) and eight Composite Regional Centres (CRCs) working for the upliftment and rehabilitation of disabled persons in various States.

Under the Indira Gandhi National Disability Pension Scheme (IGNDPS) assistance @ Rs.300/- per month is provided to persons aged 18-79 years with severe or multiple disabilities and belonging to family living Below Poverty Line (BPL) as per the criteria prescribed by Government of India. After attaining the age of 80 years, the beneficiary would be shifted to Indira Gandhi National Old Age Pension Scheme (IGNOAPS) for getting pension of Rs.500/- per month.

A Task Force was constituted under the Chairmanship of Dr. Mihir Shah, Member, Planning Commission to prepare a proposal for Comprehensive National Social Assistance Programme. Further action has been initiated keeping in view the recommendations of the Task Force.
