National Handicapped Finance and Development Corporation (NHFDC) signed Memorandum of Understanding for the financial year 2014-15, with Department of Disability Affairs, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India, New Delhi on 25.3.2014.

The MOU was signed between Ms Stuti Kacker, Secretary, Department of Disability Affairs and Shri Paresh Chandra Das, Chairman-cum-Managing Director, NHFDC.



The targets of NHFDC are to assist Persons with Disabilities under NHFDC schemes and mainly include (i) Disbursement of Loan of Rs. 100 Crore including education loan, micro credits to NGOs and scholarship for more than 2500 students, (ii) Number of beneficiaries to be assisted during the year- 14000, (iii) Number of Persons with Disabilities to be trained under Entrepreneurial Development Programmes (EDP) to help them secure employments – 1100, (iv) Participation in Regional/State Fairs/Camps/Exhibitions -22 and (v) Workshop/Awareness Camps to be organized -18.

Shri P.C. Das, Chairman-cum-Managing Director, NHFDC speaking on the occasion said that NHFDC is committed to take all necessary steps to help the Persons with Disabilities under its schemes.
