

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) About SKILL Training Scheme:

Q.(1) What does NHFDC do apart from giving loan?

A. Apart from giving loan, NHFDC provides Skill and Entrepreneurial training in emerging areas through reputed Government Institutions to educated unemployed youths of the target group. NHFDC gives 100% grant through Channelizing Agencies to Training Institutes for these programmes.

Q.(2) Is any stipend given to trainees in these training programme?

A. Yes, During the training Programmes, stipend @ Rs 2,000/- per month is paid to each trainee to cover the cost of transportation and other incidental expenses.

Q.(3) In which area Skill training is provided?

A. Some indicative Schemes for Skill training are as following :-

- Entrepreneurship Development Programme.

- Plastic Extrusion Machine Operator
- Production Supervisor and Quality Control
- Repairing & Maintenance of Diesel Engine & Power Tiller
- Repairing of Refrigerator and Air Conditioner.
- Welding and Fabrication, Electrician etc.

Q.(4) What type of facilities is provided to beneficiaries after skill training?

A. Placement assistance is provided to the beneficiaries after skill training by the respective Training Institution. Also trainees who would like to setup their own ventures, they may apply for the concessional loan under NHFDC scheme.

Q.(5) What is the procedure to get skill training programmes through NHFDC?

A. The detailed form for empanelment of skill training partner is available on NHFDC website (www.nhfdc.nic.in) throughout the year.

Q.(6) What is the trainee eligibility under the scheme?

A. The beneficiaries should be in the age group of 15-50 years and fulfill the other eligibility criteria for availing loan from NHFDC.

Q.(7) What is the duration of skill training?

A. The duration of skill training is up to 12 months.

Q.(8). Whether NHFDC have skill training centers.

A. NHFDC has two skill training centers at Faridabad (Haryana) and Ujjain (M.P.).

Q.(9) Does NHFDC have any scheme for providing loan to pursue Vocational courses?

A. Yes, NHFDC has a Vocational Education and Training Loan Scheme to provide loan upto Rs. 2.0 lakh to PwDs for pursuing vocational education and training courses.

Q.(10) What is the rate of interest under NHFDC Vocational Education and Training Loan Scheme?

A. NHFDC shall charge interest @ 1% per annum from the channelizing Agency which, in turn, shall charge 4% per annum from the beneficiaries. In case of women, an interest rebate of 0.5% shall be provided.
